With VIV Europe 2022 preparations in full swing, co-creation network organisation, HubOranje, recently held its kickoff meeting to present its roadmap to the show, which will be hosted in the Dutch city of Utrecht from 31 May to 2 June 2022.

One of the flagship projects is the floating farm concept, which will also be highlighted during VIV MEA in November in Abu Dhabi.
